The Attitude of Confidence

Our Primary Biblical Text: Matthew 8:5-10 NIV

⁵When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help. ⁶ "Lord," he said, "my servant lies at home paralyzed, suffering terribly." ⁷Jesus said to him, "Shall I come and heal him?" ⁸The centurion replied, "Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed. ⁹For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." ¹⁰When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those following him, "Truly I tell you, I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith.

The Attitude of Confidence: Sailing Under Sealed Orders Introduction

The Christian faith often requires us to move forward without all the information. We move along, placing our confidence in "Headquarters", we move forward with confidence in God. We sail under "sealed orders" until we get to the place that God wants us to be, and then we wait for instructions as to our next move.

Proverbs 3:5-6

Do you have confidence in God? Are you certain that he is at work every day in your life?

- providing for your needs
- forgiving you of your faults and short comings
- enabling you to overcome temptations
- giving you guidance
- restoring health to your body
- hearing and answering your prayers
- sustaining you through times of difficulty
- delivering you from the attacks of the devil
- and filling you with joy and peace

If you lack confidence, remember that God is able and willing to demonstrate his power in every area of your life. God, through his Son, Jesus is most certainly interested in us and wants to be intimately involved in our lives each day. Listen to the words of Jesus from the book of Revelation, "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, then I will come in to him, and will dine with him, and he with me," Revelation 3:20.

You can have fellowship with God. Genuine, Authentic, Intimate Fellowship with God.

So, what does it mean to have confidence in God? It means that you are not just wishing or hoping God is going to act in your behalf, but that you expect or that your are certain that he is at work in your circumstances. This is not wishful thinking. Our certainty is based on God's revelation of himself and the promises of his word. Now, if you want to have this certainty in your life you must first get to know God who has reveled himself though his Son, Jesus Christ and through his word.

The Bible tells us that:

- God is the creator and sustainer of life, but more than that, he is our father.
- God is consistent, he does not change
- God has purpose; he has a destiny for each one of us.
- God is personal.

- God is impartial-he treats everybody the same;
