

Game Night and Silent Auction

A FUNdraiser for the Emanuel Lisk Center for Youth Development Instructions/Logistics for Registrants

INSTRUCTIONS: ALL ATTENDEES

- The Game Night and Silent Auction will begin at 5:00 p.m., and doors will open at 4:00 p.m.
- Bring Your Own Everything: tablecloth and decorations if seated at a sponsored table, tableware, food (unless a meal was purchased in advance), and beverages. Additional beverages will be available for purchase onsite.
- There will be <u>no</u> access to electric outlets, the kitchen, or an area for food storage. Everything you bring will need to fit on or under your table during the event.
- Check in upon arrival to receive directions to your table and meal tickets for any purchased meals. Purchased meals will be available at 5:00 p.m.
 - Sponsored tables will be reserved. Tables for individual patrons/single ticket holders will have open seating, and a tablecloth will be provided.
 - Wristbands will be provided to all attendees. Individual patrons will receive a wristband at check in. Table Sponsors will receive all 8 wristbands for their guests upon check in and will be responsible for distributing them to their guests.
- Only 8 guests may sit at a table.

INSTRUCTIONS: SPONSORED TABLES

- Before the event, confer with your table guests to select a color for the table competition and pick out
 fun table decorations and food items to highlight that color. (See examples below. Reminder:
 Tablecloths, chair covers, etc. will NOT be provided for sponsored tables.) Table guests may even
 coordinate their outfits and/or accessories to highlight their color.
- Please arrive by or before 4:00 p.m. to set up your table and decorations. (You can arrive as early as 3:00 p.m. if more time is needed.)
- Table judging will begin promptly at 5:15 p.m. Please encourage your entire team to be present. The table that highlights their color the best will win a \$100 cash prize.







DETAILS: SILENT AUCTION

- Bidders must be 18+ years old and agree to the rules and regulations presented before bidding opens.
 Bidding begins at 5:00 p.m. and ends at 7:30 p.m.
- Each item will have a starting bid, depending on the value of the item. The highest qualifying bid at the closing time is the winning bid.
- Payment for items purchased must be made in full on the night of the auction via cash, check or credit card.
- Please refer to the Silent Auction rules for more information.

DETAILS: TRIVIA via KAHOOT!

- The game for the evening will be trivia played through Kahoot!, an online platform where speed and accuracy are crucial. Trivia questions will be in a multiple-choice format and cover general topics.
- Guests seated at a sponsored table will play as one multiplayer team. Individual patrons, who will be
 at open seating tables, have two options to play: individually as a single-player team OR as a
 multiplayer team with their fellow table mates.
- Each team will use one smart device (phone, tablet, etc.), which you are responsible for providing, to play the Kahoot! trivia game. All other devices are prohibited. You will select a team name before the game starts, using your smart device.
 - Bring a wireless charger or additional power supply to ensure your device is fully charged throughout the game. Electrical outlets and extension cords will **not** be available for use.
 - We strongly suggest you bring a hotspot or your phone's 4G/5G service for internet access. Friendship's Wi-Fi could be delayed due to the heavy volume. (Friendship is not responsible for lost connections to the internet during the game.)
- All teams will select one person to submit their responses using a personal smart device. You can
 work collaboratively to discuss the questions and responses, but only one person will enter the
 team's response.
- Team names will appear on an electronic leaderboard, and scores will be posted and tracked electronically throughout the game.
- In Kahoot!, points are awarded based on two main factors: **speed and accuracy**. The faster you answer a question correctly, the more points you will receive. This means being quick on your feet is vital to maximizing your score.
 - There is also an "Answer Streak bonus feature" that gives additional points for consecutive correct answers to reduce guessing and encourage critical thinking! The bonus compounds on top of the above points system. Answering questions correctly will increase your "answer streak." If you answer incorrectly, you will decrease your score.
- The winning team (single-player or multiplayer) will receive a \$100 cash prize.
