1. FOCAL SCRIPTURES

2. BIG IDEA

Life changes, but God's character, presence, and promises remain the same.



3. LESSON AIM

- Recognize that change is a normal part of life.
- Trust God's unchanging character in changing seasons.
- Find stability in God instead of in circumstances.



4. OPENING THOUGHT

What is one thing about life today that is very different from years ago? What has that change taught you about God?



5. TEACHING TRUTHS

Change Is Part of Life

Ecclesiastes 3:1 reminds us that every season has its time. Change does not always mean something is wrong; often it means life has entered a new season.

God Does Not Change

Hebrews 13:8 teaches that while circumstances shift, Jesus remains the same in love, power, mercy, and faithfulness.

God Is Our Stability

Psalm 46:1–3 declares that even when the world feels unsettled, God is our refuge, strength, and present help.

- How can you place your confidence in God this week?
